Program Overview

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Loan Payoff

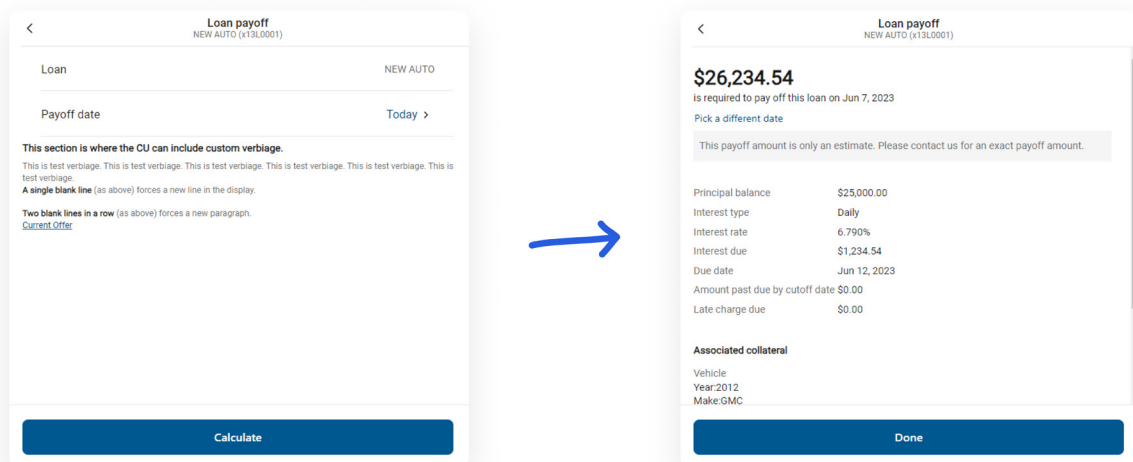
This PowerOn allows the user to request a loan payoff amount including interest and late fees for a selected date.

Loan payoffs are only available on in-house loans. The payoff option will not display for any third-party loans. Credit card loans will not display the interest rate as they typically have different interest rates for different portions of the balance.

UX Run-Time Detail

Upon the member electing to run the program, the Banno UX displays the loan selected and Payoff Date. The Payoff Date defaults to today, but the member may click the link to select a future payoff date from a calendar. Customizable Terms and Conditions verbiage will also display to the member.

Upon selecting Calculate, a Loan Payoff screen is displayed for the member to view the calculated payoff amount and details.



PowerOn Run-Time Detail

When first run by the member, Banno passes back to the PowerOn the account and loan ID the member is requesting payoff for. The program takes this information, reads the various parameter settings from the configuration Letter file and determines account eligibility. The PowerOn will pass back to the UX if the loan is eligible, the number of days in the future a payoff can be requested, and the terms and conditions. If eligible, once the member selects the desired payoff date, that date is passed back to the PowerOn from the Banno UX and the PowerOn then calculates the loan payoff amount. It then passes this information to the Banno UX to be presented to the member.

Program Setup & Installation

Required Files

- REPWRITERSPECS folder
 - » BANNO.LOAN.PAYOFF.V1.POW (Main PowerOn Program)
 - » BANNO.LOAN.PAYOFF.FEES.POW (Optional – subroutine PowerOn responsible for returning additional fees)
 - » Standard PowerOn library include files which should already be in your system:
 - RD.GETDATA.DEF
 - RB.LISTEXPAND.DEF
 - RB.LISTEXPAND
- LETTERSPECS folder
 - » BANNO.LOAN.PAYOFF.V1.CFG (Main program configuration Letter file)

Installation Steps

1. Upload files to their respective directories
 - » Recommend using Symitar PC Transfer.
2. Install the PowerOn programs for demand use
3. Add the Main PowerOn program name to SymXchange Common Parameters

4. In Device Control take SymXChange – Banno Off Host
5. Put SymXchange – Banno back On Host and verify Status = On Host
6. Update the settings in the configuration Letter file
 - » The configuration Letter file contains details for the various settings.
7. Add the program to Banno People

Configuration Letter File

The configuration Letter file allows certain aspects of the program to be customized to better suit your needs. Among the options which can be set are:

- Determine member eligibility by account warning code(s).
- Determine loan eligibility by loan type(s), loan warning code(s).
- Determine the number of days in the future for which a loan payoff can be requested.
- Determine home loan, boat loan, vehicle loan, and secured loan types to identify collateral for display.
- Set Terms and Conditions to be displayed to the member regarding the payoff.
- Set fee PowerOn name if additional loan payoff fees should be included/displayed.

The configuration Letter file contains full instructions on setting these run-time parameters. Do pay close attention when selecting your options making sure to set each option within the required parameters.

Database Interaction

Data Sources

Data utilized by the program is pulled from the following sources:

- Member's open internal loan records
- Loan Tracking records
- Loan Name records
- Loan Pledge records

Additional Information

Loan Tracking Records

The program uses these tracking records to store boat and vehicle collateral information. The credit union can specify in the configuration Letter file which loan tracking types to use and which field(s) contain collateral information.

Fee PowerOn

Subroutine PowerOn can be modified to return up to 10 custom fee amounts and descriptions to the Banno UX for display. Custom fee logic must be added directly to this program. (No actual fees are posted by this PowerOn. The return data is for display only.)
